MECOPP is an Edinburgh based charity providing a range of supports and services to informal carers and those in receipt of care across Scotland. We work primarily with communities who experience disadvantage due to ethnicity, age, disability or other protected characteristics.

range of different ethnic groups.
Working closely with individuals, we
aim to improve the health, wellbeing and
resilience of carers to better enable them to
manage their caring role. We also work to raise awareness of the
specific needs of BME carers and to support service providers to
better respond to their needs. Our direct service provision is only
available within Edinburgh and the Lothians.

What we do



- We provide **advice and information**, both written and spoken, in a range of community languages on rights and entitlements, health, social care, welfare benefits and other community-based services.
- We provide advocacy and casework support to help carers and cared for people access the supports and services needed to assist them in their caring role including applying for welfare benefits and other forms of financial support.
- We provide a range of **social**, **recreational and therapeutic activities** to support and improve the mental health and wellbeing of carers and cared for people.
- We deliver awareness-raising sessions to a wide range of service providers and practitioners which aim to dispel myths and encourage culturally competent practice.
- We **advise on, and develop policy**, at both local and national Government level.
